State of Maine Library of Geographic Information for 3-D Hydrographic Data Project

Recipient: State of Maine Library of Geographic Information

Location: Augusta, ME (statewide)

Amount Requested: \$2,261,000

Project Purpose: To process LiDAR data into a 3-dimensional hydrology map database as a reference standard for hydro mapping in Maine to understand the impacts of water flows. The new mapping data will replace the National Wetlands Inventory and will be provided to the State and public users.

Maine Department of Marine Resources for Restoring Access to Habitat

Recipient: Maine Department of Marine Resources

Location: Baileyville, ME

Amount Requested: \$4,000,000

Project Purpose: To construct a new fishway at Grand Falls Dam in Baileyville, Maine to restore access to hundreds of miles of river and tens of thousands of acres of fish habitat.

Amount Requested: \$1,677,000

Project Purpose: To upgrade vulnerable and aging wastewater facilities to improve reliability, safety, and treatment technology.
