Proposal Name: Furthering the Goals of the Maine Offshore Wind Research Consortium

Project Purpose: To support the Maine Offshore Wind Research Consortium, a nation-leading cross-sector program that includes fishing industry members to help ensure a sustainable, innovative offshore wind industry alongside a thriving seafood economy and Gulf of Maine ecosystem. Funding will support key priorities identified by the broad consortium to avoid and minimize potential impacts from offshore wind and provide tangible results to highlight University of Maine technology and inform future floating offshore wind in the Gulf of Maine, nation, and around the world.

Amount Requested: \$2,000,000

Recipient: University of Maine System

Proposal Name: BioHome3D: Scaling Up the Technology to Address Critical Affordable Housing Shortage in Maine

Project Purpose: To address the critical shortage of affordable homes in Maine, on behalf the R1 University of Maine, to accelerate the manufacturing scale-up and commercialization of its breakthrough BioHome3D housing construction technology.

Amount Requested: \$4,000,000

Recipient: Our Katahdin

Proposal Name: Renewable Energy Generation at the One North Innovation Hub

Project Purpose: In keeping with Our Katahdin's goal of developing leading technologies for the use of wood fiber, Our Katahdin will install a highly efficient biomass power plant to generate electricity and provide thermal energy to the district heating at the Innovation Hub.
